SEVILLE

Boat Trip on the Guadalquivir

We propose a one-hour boat ride on the Guadalquivir, mythical and legendary river, the only navigable in Spain. From the boat we can contemplate the classic Seville, with its elegant bridges such as San Telmo or Triana, the Giralda, the Bullring, the popular neighborhood of Triana or the towers of the Plaza de España, as well as the Seville more avant-garde, reflected in the constructions made on the occasion of Expo 92, such as the modern bridges of the Cartuja and the Alamillo, the most emblematic pavilions of the Island of the Cartuja or the Theater of the Maestranza.

Flamenco with one drink or tapas dinner

We will move to the Island of Cartuja to attend a flamenco show, in an imposing space that recreates the aesthetics of the old Sevillian singers cafes. A place where art and passion come together to show all the flamenco lovers, the depth of their roots, the feeling of their land and the sensitivity of their performers. Includes one drink or tapas dinner (drinks included) per person during the show.

GRANADA

Flamenco Zambra

The origin of the word *Zambra* comes from the Arabic *zamra* (flute) or from the classical Arabic *zamara* (musicians). The gypsy zambra was born in Sacromonte, in the caves of the gypsies. This flamenco singing and dancing is inspired by Muslim weddings of the city. During the persecutions of the Moors, they join the gypsies, so that the latter are enriched by their art. The zambra that we can see today is based on a mestizo folklore, very passional, emotional and sentimental, away from the academic spectacle of traditional flamenco. During the show, one drink is included.

In addition, you will enjoy a short walk through the streets of Granada and delight in the view of the Alhambra from one of the viewpoints of the city.

COSTA DEL SOL

White Villages – Mijas

Mijas is one of the most typical and attractive white villages in Andalusia. The population extends through the mountainside, with the white houses contrasting with the green of the pine trees. We will have the opportunity to tour the old town, with its picturesque "donkey taxis", its old churches, the remains of the old fortress and its charming viewpoint, with spectacular views.

Málaga

We propose a visit to get to know this city on the shores of the Mediterranean, birthplace of Pablo Picasso. Málaga is a city full of corners that look back on several centuries of history, from the time of the Romans (with its mangnificent theater) to the Arab, with the Alcazaba or the Castle of Gibralfaro (which we will visit during this activity). The most contemporary part, with its Cathedral, the lively Larios Street or the new Museums (Picasso museum, Pompidou Center...) complete the mosaic of different cultures and eras that is the Málaga of today.

VALENCIA

Modernist Valencia + Dinner with Paella

We propose a tour of the most unknown Valencia, the Modernist Valencia. At the end of the 19th century the city of Valencia experienced an important political and social development, which was reflected in the architecture of the city. We will discover the Paseo de la Alameda, the Ensanche, with significant buildings such as the Casa Chapa or the Ortega house, to continue to the neighborhood of Colón, from which we will start a walking tour that will reveal an eclectic and original city: the Casa de los Dragones, and its commercial area, the Plaza del Patriarca and the Palace of the Marquis de dos Aguas, the street of La Paz, the most modernist city and entry point of medieval Valencia, Our tour will end at a local restaurant where we will enjoy the original and authentic Valencian paella. The menu consists of starters, Valencian paella, dessert, coffee and a drink.

SAN SEBASTIÁN

Biarritz and Saint-Jean-de-Luz

We offer you the possibility of moving to the neighbouring country, France, and getting to know two of the most beautiful towns in the French Basque Country.

Biarritz, located between the sea and the Pyrenees, was once chosen by European royalty to spend their holidays. Its hot springs, its idyllic streets and the more than 6 km. of sandy areas and cliffs create a space worthy of admiration.

Saint-Jean-de-Luz is a small and idyllic corner of the Basque coast. Ancient corsair city, encourages us to enjoy its colorful facades, its traditional fishing port and its large promenade.

OVIEDO

Walking tour of Oviedo with a visit to the Cathedral and Pre-Romanesque Churches

We will move to the outskirts of Oviedo to visit the church of San Julián de Frutos, built at the end of the 8th century and the oldest of the Asturian pre-Romanesque churches. We will continue with a panoramic tour of the city where we can enjoy the modern Ensanche of Oviedo, Palace of Parliament, San Francisco Park, Congress Palace, among other wonders of this city. We will walk on foot through the old town, with its medieval past, shopping malls, Plaza del Fontán and see its impressive sculptures. We will enter the magnificent cathedral of El Salvador and admire its impressive interior, its Gothic architecture, Roman sculptures, Holy Chamber and cloister. And we will finish with a cider tasting in a typical Asturian cider house

PONTEVEDRA

Ría Arousa – Rute of the mussels

We will enjoy a marine excursion along the Ría de Arousa with an approximate duration of 1:15 min in which we will visit the mussels' farm and explain the way the mussels, oysters and scallops are cultivated.We will have the pleasure of observing underwater panoramas through the bottom of the glass of our catamaran and we will finish with a tasting on board of mussels with water, wine or soft drinks.

PORTO

Visit to Guimarães

Guimarães is one of the oldest cities in Portugal, cradle of the Portuguese nation, whose historic center is considered a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. In this city, we will have the opportunity to learn about Portuguese history and visit, among other monuments, the Castle (Castelo de Guimaraes) dating from the 10th century, and the Palace of the Dukes of Bragança. Built in the fifteenth century, it was the residence of the royal family. Here we will pay tribute to the first king of Portugal, Mr. Alfonso Henriques. We can also walk the streets of the historic center and hear a little more about its secrets and stories, and visit the typical local art and craft stores.

LISBON

Fado show with dinner

Enjoy a typical Portuguese dinner visiting one of the oldest Fado venues in the city and located in one of the most interesting cultural neighborhoods in the area.

With this activity, you can enjoy a typical dinner to discover some flavors of the Portuguese cuisine while listening to the intimate and enveloping interpretation of Fado, named by UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Then we will go to Cabo de Roca, the easternmost point of the European continent where you can enjoy wonderful views of the Atlantic Ocean. We will return to Lisbon through the coastal town of Cascais and the cosmopolitan city of Estoril, known for its famous Casino (the largest in Europe).
